Who should complete a Trading Partner Profile Registration for Missouri EDI Claims Release 3.1?

- All Claims Administrators, Insurers, Self-Insured/Self-Administered Employers, and Third-Party Administrators who will be submitting data to Missouri via a Direct SFTP connection, Jurisdiction Web Entry, or EDI Vendor must complete a New Missouri EDI Claims Release 3.1 Trading Partner Profile.
- If you are an Insurer or Self-Insured Employer who uses a Third-Party Administrator, you are not required to register; however, you must ensure that your Third-Party Administrator includes your company on their Trading Partner Profile Registration.

If you have not completed a new trading partner profile registration for the transition from IAIABC EDI Claims Release 1.0 to Release 3.1, please have this completed no later than Wednesday, June 4th, 2025.
