Missouri Division of Workers' Compensation (MODWC) EDI Claims Release 3.1

Updated Transition Plan and Test Plan Documents

Date: 12/2/2025

Please review the updated MODWC transition from IAIABC Claims Release 1 to IAIABC Claims Release 3.1 Timeline Summary and MODWC Test Plan and Test Feedback Request List that reflect the new Implementation Date. These documents are posted on the Implementation Info page of the MODWC website: <https://modwcedi.info/impl-info>.

The testing period for MODWC Trading Partners (Direct SFTP) and EDI Vendors became available starting July 14, 2025. FROI Testing is expected to be completed by December 8, 2025, and SROI Testing is expected to be completed by March 2, 2026, to allow time for review of completed Testing Feedback Request Lists. EDI Vendors and Trading Partners submitting claims data directly are required to complete the Test Plan.

Any Direct SFTP trading partner or EDI Vendor who has not completed and passed the FROI/SROI testing will not be advanced to production.

Exceptions: No testing is required for the low volume entry Jurisdiction Web Entry filers. In some cases, if a Trading Partner is using an EDI Vendor, the EDI Vendor will coordinate and/or perform the testing on behalf of the Trading Partner.

Please note the following important information regarding the incoming test files:

- Must contain proper information consistent with the approved method on the TPP
- Test/Production Indicator (DN0104) located in position 82 of the Header Record should be set to 'T' for all testing

Trading Partner Profile Registration: If you have not completed a new trading partner profile registration for the transition from IAIABC EDI Claims Release 1.0 to Release 3.1, please have this completed. Missouri's EDI Claims Release 3.1 Trading Partner Registration can be found online at <https://modwcedi.info/register>. Detailed registration instructions on how to complete the online form is available on the website for download. As a Trading Partner, you must complete the trading partner profile registration in or to be advanced to production.

We will send a separate announcement in the future to advise once the MODWC Claims EDI Release 3.1 Requirement Tables become available on the website.
